The Major Crops in the area are Rice, Wheat, Barley, Maize, Ragi (Mandua) and so forth. Measurable subtleties on the harvests are accessible in 'detail at a Glance of the District'.

## 1.5 Horticulture

Uttarakhand is known for its agricultural products, which incorporate natural products, vegetables, offseason vegetables and floricultural harvests, restorative and fragrant plants. # 2. MEDICAL FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN RUDRAPUR CITY

The Jawaharlal Nehru Hospital, Rudrapur was established years ago and now it is District Hospital of Udham Singh Nagar. After the establishment of the SIDCUL, the population of the district is gradually increasing due to development and availability of opportunities of employment and new SIDCULs are continuously being established. Although government is taking great steps for development but there has not been any arrangement for providing people with health facilities in equal proportions be it number of haospitals or primary and community health centres. Owing to increase in the population, there are so many difficulties that have arisen before the locals inhabiting this district like lack of water, electricity, good education, housing, travel facilities and roads etc. The main problem which arises before the people residing in the District is the problem of lack of medical facilities one of the problems is the increase in the population during last few years due to establishment

SIDCUL but medical facilities have not increased in equal proportion. The result of lack of good hospitals, doctors and primary health care centers etc in Rudrapur District Udham Singh Nagar has affected the lives of people very adversely. The SIDCUL is an important industrial belt and agricultural hub of

Uttrakhand. An acute shortage of doctors in district hospital is also a great problem due to which the people of the district are facing problems in management of health issues. As such, there is a situation where only about 25% doctors (of the required number) are currently working in the hospitals and health centers of the area leading to denial of basic health facilities the bulk of almost 16 lakh people in the district. In many areas like Jaspur, Gadarapur etc. doctors refused to join duties feeling threat to safety of their lives. In April last year, unidentified gunmen shot dead a Pediatrician, Dr. Sunil Kumar Singh, who was attending a child patient at a Community Health Centre (CHC) in Jaspur. Ever since that incident, no doctor wants to join the Jaspur CHC and it is being run by just two doctors against the sanctioned posts [7]

The condition of six other CHCs, 26 Primary Health Centers (PHCs), two hospitals and 21 Block Hospitals and Medical Units in the district is also the same. According to data available with the Chief Medical Officer's (CMO) Office, there are only 52 doctors in the district, against the total 203 sanctioned posts. Meaning thereby, 151 doctors are currently needed for the running the hospitals. Dr. R. K. Pandey, C.M.O. told TOI, "Shortage of doctors is a major problem for us. The matter has been brought to the notice of the Directorate of Health & Family Welfare. We have been assured that the issue will be taken up with Chief Minister Trivendra Singh Rawat, who also holds the Health Ministry Portfolio."[8] District hospitals Rudrapur, which has 125 bed in patient facility, was established in the year 2006 on recommendation of Medical Inquiry

Committee of Uttrakhand, formed by Government of Uttarakhand, to facilitate proper and easy of treatment of patients coming to the hospital. At present, this district hospital is providing its services to more than 1,65,00 patients. This hospital is not providing its services to the patients from within the district only, but also to the patients coming from the adjoining areas of from Uttar Pradesh such as Rampur, Bilaspur, Pilibhit, Bahedi etc. All B.P.L patients in the district hospital are treated and their tests are done free of cost, not only this, other poor and helpless persons are also being provided hospital facilities. An amount of Rs.1.75.000/- under Chief Minister Health Insurance Scheme is provided for this work. District headquarter is established in the ditrict where people go for redressal of their grievances related to availability of basic amenities. Under N.R.H.M. program, mother and child are treated free of charge for 30 days after delivery. At present, all the national programs, such as, R.H.M., all facilities related to test and management of AIDS,

blindness, R.N.T.C.P. and family welfare are being provided in the district hospital [9].

Various types of test and investigation are available for patients in the hospital. According to the data received, the following medical equipments and other facilities are available in District Hospital Rudrapur, District Udham Singh Nagar
